PRAYER POINTS

Psalm 34:8 Taste and see that the Lord is good; blessed is the one who takes refuge in Him.

Pray for the 360 million Christians world wide who are denied access to jobs and education, are arrested or attacked for following Jesus. **Pray** for the families of those who are killed for their faith. **Pray** for the victims of violence and injustice.

- · 13 Christians killed every day
- · 12 churches or Christian buildings attacked on average
- · 5,600 Christians murdered
- · More than 6,000 detained or imprisoned
- · More than 4,000 kidnapped
- · More than 5,000 churches and other religious facilities destroyed

In the following countries, Christians face the most persecution: Burma, China, Eritrea, India, Iran, Nigeria, North Korea, Pakistan, Russia, Saudi Arabia, Syria, and Vietnam.

Pray for the sick, unwell or isolated in our church, that God will bring not only healing, but also joy and peace. **Pray** for Peter, Colin, Sandra, Annette, Ann and Bob, Aub. Pray for their health and health professionals.

Pray for continued and complete healing.

Pray for Lesley as she adjusts to life in Queensland.

Pray for Israel and the current conflict in the Middle East and surrounding countries and territories. **Pray** that all hostilities cease.

Pray for India and Pakistan. Pray for peace.

Pray that Putin will cease hostilities with Ukraine. **Pray** for the Ukrainian people: those who have fled to other countries and those who can not leave and those who choose to stay and fight.

The group has now rescued 3 children and that is something worth celebrating when we stop to consider where they were before being rescued.

- · Our year on year growth now places our rescues at an average of 16 per day, 365 days a year!
- · Our rescue total so far in 2025 is 2959 and counting.

We appreciate and thank God for the generosity of church family willing to share produce with other church members.

We ask that you consider the following;

You are probably aware that there have been several fruit fly outbreaks in the Riverland.

When this happens the authorities designate areas around the site of the outbreak with those closest – the "Red" area - being subject to the strictest rules for fruit movement.

LIVING WATERS IS IN THE RED ZONE

FEEL FREE TO FAMILIARISE YOURSELF WITH THE REGULATIONS SURROUNDING THIS GOVERNMENT MANDATED ORDER REGARDING RESTRICTED FRUIT AND VEGETABLES AT THE WEBSITE https://fruitfly.sa.gov.au/

RESTRICTIONS HAVE BEEN EXTENDED 'TIL NOV 2, 2025

NB: there is up to \$100,000 fines for Non Compliance.

This means:

ANYONE TAKING RESTRICTED FRUIT FROM THE CHURCH CAN BE FINED
